Remember....

- Use scaffolds per manufacturer specifications
- Competent persons are required to oversee assembly, disassembly, inspection, and maintenance of scaffolds
- Competent Persons must:
 - o Be designated by the employer
 - o Capable of identifying hazards
 - o Have the authority to take prompt corrective actions to correct hazards with the scaffold
- Common hazards associated with scaffolds include:
 - o Falls
 - Falling object(s)
 - o Electrical hazards
 - o Collapse hazards
 - o Planking hazards
 - o Weather conditions
 - o Collisions or struck-by

- Methods to reduce/eliminate hazards:
 - o Provide proper access
 - o Install quardrails
 - o Provide Personal Fall Arrest System (PFAS)
 - o Provide Protection from falling objects & wear hard hats
 - o Ensure scaffolds are erected an adequate distance away from electrical hazards
 - o Take precautions when moving scaffolds
- Do not use cross braces or unapproved ladder-like ends for access
