Remember....

- Silica is often found in:
 - Foundries that use sand in mold and core-making processes
 - Steel and other metal processing used in some refractories
 - o Coal mining
 - o Quarries and cement mills
 - o Oil and gas well fracking operations
 - Construction concrete cutting, demolition, removing old pointing
- **Employers must:**
 - o Know that there is silica in the workplace
 - o Know what the silica exposure levels are
 - o Provide training to employees
 - o Control or eliminate silica exposures through engineering controls
 - Provide PPE

- Employers can minimize exposure by:
 - Understanding where silica may be present in the workplace
 - o Adopting work practices that minimize exposure
 - o Wearing designated PPE
 - o Using local exhaust ventilation
 - o Using wet methods Use tools with water to reduce airborne silica
 - Using tools with dust-collecting systems
