- Academic Programs

 - Credit for prior learning
 - Ability to stand up and stand down credentials per market demand
 - Recognized credentials
 - Curriculum in smaller units which can stand alone or be connected to meet degree requirements
 - Provide general education content for students who may drop in repeatedly for skill development
