Further, the proposed IUPCOM does not currently accept any credit earned at another institution for purposes of transfer, nor does it apply transfer credit to any courses.

The proposed IUPCOM does not currently have any articulation agreements with institutions for transferring from another college of osteopathic medicine accredited by the American Osteopathic Association's Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation (COCA), or any other school of medicine accredited by the Liaison Committee on Medical Education (LCME).
