All students at the proposed IUPCOM will have confidential access to an effective system of counseling and mental health care from mental health care providers, with access 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, from all locations where students receive education. It is recognized that students spend half of their time as medical students at the proposed IUPCOM off campus at an array of clinical training locations at affiliated clinical partners. While students have access to on campus mental health services, as well as distance mental health counseling, it is also important to have a network of clinical mental health providers available at the various clinical sites in the event a student needs to access them.

A. Resources Available at All Sites via Distance Technology or Remote Services

Whether on campus or off, students have access to these resources 24 hours a day, 7 days a week:

- 2. <u>TogetherAll</u>. TogetherAll offers 24/7 online mental health support. - 4. <u>Crisis Walk-In Centers and 24/7/365 Crisis Access</u>: Nulton Diagnostics provides not only walk-in hours for patients in crisis, but also 24/7/365 access to a mobile mental health service that comes to the client in need. B. On Campus

While on campus in Indiana, PA, students have access to in-person as well as the above distance/telephonic resources for mental health care.

- 1. <u>Confidential, In-Person Counseling</u>. The *IUP Center for Applied Psychology* offers no-fee counseling to all IUP students, including medical students, available Monday—Friday, 8:00 a.m.—4:30 p.m., and can be reached at 724-357-6228 or <u>counseling-center@iup.edu</u>. - 4. <u>Local clinics</u>. There are several clinics located here in Indiana, PA, or within a few miles' drive, which have agreed to accept students in need of mental health care. See *Table 1*, below, and look under the "Indiana" listing in Column 1.

C. Off Campus

While at the clinical rotation sites, students have access to the following mental health services. This is not an extensive list but is one which will be provided to students as a "starting point" for locating mental health resources in the regions of their clinical sites. This list was compiled by both contacting affiliated clinical sites and inquiring about local mental health providers who would potentially be able to see IUPCOM students who are based at those sites if they need mental health care (there is a mix of counseling-based services and medication/medical-based mental health services listed).

Nulton Diagnostics and Treatment Centers (NDTC) has more than 11 sites throughout PA, with at least one location in the vicinity of each of our core clinical training centers. We have a commitment from NDTC for the provision of psychiatric services, if needed, for medical students, both if on campus in the Indiana area, as well as on rotations at the distant clinical education sites (see bolded, and italicized, entries on Table 1, below), and see attached letter from Larry Nulton, Ph.D., owner and founder of Nulton Diagnostics and Treatment Centers).

We also have commitments for the provision of medical services, if needed, for students at Hyndman Area Health Center (HAHC), Broad Top Area Medical Center (BTAMC), and Primary Health Network (PHN), which are submitted under *Pre-Accreditation Submission 9.9-3*, which covers behavioral health services as well as primary care medical services. The other sites

listed are additional sites referred to us by the clinical campus sites as entities which would be accepting of our students.

All sites will receive a copy of the *Non-Academic Health Professions* policy (as submitted under *Pre-Accreditation Submissions 9.10-1 and 9.10-3*) will be provided to ensure that no providers treating students will be involved in the promotion or academic assessment of the student receiving the services. **Table 1**, below, lists mental health services available to students while off campus at clinical rotation sites throughout Pennsylvania. Each clinical site (Column 1) has been assigned to a geographic region (Column 2), and within that geographic region are the listed mental health service names, location, and hours of operation (Columns 3-5).

Each geographical region's site starts with the nearest emergency department that students may go to in the event of an emergency which is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week; subsequent to that, there are listings of sites to which students can visit to receive mental health services, both counseling and medication management services.
