COCA Pre-Accreditation Element 9.9: Physical Health Services

Pre-Accreditation Submission 9.9-3: Physical Health Services at All Teaching Locations

All students at the proposed IUPCOM will have access to an effective system of diagnostic, preventative, and therapeutic health services from all locations where students receive education. It is recognized that students spend half of their time as medical students at the proposed IUPCOM off campus at an array of clinical training locations at affiliated clinical partners. While students have access to on campus physical health services, as well as some services provided via telemedicine, it is also important to have a network of physical health providers available at the various clinical sites in the event a student needs to access them.

**On Campus**

While on campus in Indiana, PA, students have access to in-person diagnostic, preventative, and therapeutic physical health services:

1. **IUP Center for Health and Well-Being (Health Services).** Skilled, competent, and caring health professionals provide patient education and medical services to students to improve students' wellness and sustain their health. The Health Service's goal is to help students be successful in their academic endeavors. As members of both the IUP and health care communities, the health service staff works collaboratively to identify and advocate for student needs and to provide appropriate high-quality, cost-effective responses. For emergency medical care when the IUP Health Service is not open, they recommend students go to the nearest emergency department or Indiana Regional Medical Center or call 911 (9-911 if on campus). There is a blue emergency phone at both ends of the Center for Health and Well-Being and at 73 other locations throughout the IUP campus which can be utilized in the case of an emergency ([Blue Light Phones - University Police - IUP](#)). 2. **On-Campus Clinic Walk-In Hours.** The Health Services Center is available for walk in appointments Monday to Friday 8am, to 5pm.
3. **Local clinics.** There are several clinics located here in Indiana, PA, or within a few miles' drive, which have agreed to accept students in need of healthcare. See Table 1, below, and look under the "Indiana" listing in Column 1.

**Off Campus**

While at the clinical rotation sites, students have access to the following physical health services. This is not an extensive list but is one which will be provided to students as a “starting point” for locating physical health resources in the regions of their clinical sites. This list was compiled by both contacting affiliated clinical sites and inquiring about local health providers who would potentially be able to see IUPCOM students who are based at those sites if they need health care.

We have a commitment for the provision physical health services, if needed by medical students, at three large primary care Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) health networks in Pennsylvania located in the regions where our students will be completing clinical rotations; there is at least one location of one of these three large entities in each of the regions students will be in for clinical rotations, meaning that each student has a short drive to at least one of the entities of each center at each rotation site; see bolded, and italicized, entries on **Table 1**, below. Those centers are:

- (1) **Hyndman Area Health Centers (HAHC);**
- (2) **Primary Health Network (PHN);** and
- (3) **Broad Top Area Medical Centers (BTAMC).**

The letters representing these commitments are appended to the end of this submission, and these sites are noted in **Table 1** in bold, and italicized font. The other sites listed are additional sites referred to us by the clinical campus sites as entities which would be accepting of our students in need of physical health services.

Please also note that these FQHCs have mental health services available and are also accepting of our students who may need these services at their locations throughout Pennsylvania (see *Pre-Accreditation Submission 9.8-3* for more detail on this). Finally, each of these sites also offer additional services, such as dental, podiatry, pediatrics (for those with families), and similarly these services are available to students who are in need.

For all sites, a copy of the *Non-Academic Health Professions* policy (as submitted under *Pre-Accreditation Submissions 9.10-1 and 9.10-3*) will be provided to ensure that no providers treating students will be involved in the promotion or academic assessment of the student receiving the services. **Table 1**, below, lists physical health services available to students while off campus at clinical rotation sites throughout Pennsylvania. Each clinical site (Column 1) has been assigned to a geographic region (Column 2), and within that geographic region are the listed health service names, location, and hours of operation (Columns 3-5).

Each geographical region’s site starts with the nearest emergency department that students may go to in the event of an emergency which is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week; after that, there are listings of sites to which students can visit to receive physical health services. Note that many of these sites include 27/7/365 availability via the on-call hotline, including our three FQHC affiliates (BTAMC, HAHC, and PHN).
