PAID School Psychology Internship Opportunity for the 2024-2025 School Year

Bellwood-Antis School District, a rural district with approximately 1400 students, is seeking a School Psychology Intern for the 2024-2025 school year. District programs include K-12 services within 2 buildings on the same campus, MTSS for reading, math, and behavior K-4, technology integration K-12, grade level collaboration meetings, SAP programs K-12, and 3 Autistic Support classrooms supported by PaTTAN Autism Initiative. The School Psychologist's role includes instructional and behavioral consultation, staff development, parent trainings, comprehensive educational evaluations including neuropsychological assessments (e.g. NEPSY-II, D-KEFS), functional behavioral assessments, and development of data collection tools and positive behavior support plans. Counselling experiences are coordinated with the School Social Worker and supervised by the School Psychologist. Paid stipend will be \$20,000.

Desirable applicants will:

- Possess strong communication skills (written and verbal)
- Possess strong organizational skills
- Be willing to take initiative
- Be able to independently manage their time and assigned workload
- Be resourceful and willing to research unfamiliar topics
- Be willing to collaborate with a variety of staff and work well with others
- Be willing to accept direction and apply constructive feedback to improve performance
