



School Psychology Internship

Fairview School District is partnering with the Pennsylvania Department of Education to offer a \$20,000 paid internship during the 2023-24 School Year for non-Pennsylvania residents*

Opportunities within this internship:

- Two supervising school psychologists with diverse backgrounds, including out-of-state experience
- K-12 placement, with Early Intervention evaluations in the spring
- District-based Autistic Support and Life-Skills Support classrooms
- Supervising school psychologists are administrators, so this internship will include experience working directly with the entire district administration team
- Current district initiatives being led by school psychologists
 - Redesigning student support (data-based pre-referral) process
 - Year 1 of PBIS implementation
 - Universal mental health screening
 - MTSS structure for behavior, social-emotional learning, and mental health
 - Groups at elementary, middle, and high school level
 - Collaboration with Allegheny Health Network Chill Project
