

## School Psychology Internship

Fairview School District is partnering with the Pennsylvania Department of Education to offer a \$20,000 paid internship during the 2023-24 School Year for non-Pennsylvania residents\*

Opportunities within this internship:



- -Two supervising school psychologists with diverse backgrounds, including out-of-state experience
- -K-12 placement, with Early Intervention evaluations in the spring
- -District-based Autistic Support and Life-Skills Support classrooms
- -Supervising school psychologists are administrators, so this internship will include experience working directly with the entire district administration team
- -Current district initiatives being led by school psychologists
  - -Redesigning student support (data-based pre-referral) process
  - -Year 1 of PBIS implementation
  - -Universal mental health screening
  - -MTSS structure for behavior, social-emotional learning, and mental health
  - -Groups at elementary, middle, and high school level
  - -Collaboration with Allegheny Health Network Chill Project

#### To Apply

Provide a letter of interest, resume, letter of recommendation, and a writing sample (sample report, assessment result write-up, etc.)

\*An out of state graduate student is a student with primary residency in a state other than Pennsylvania. Verification of residency via a valid drivers' license, voter registration, or other means is required. The student may be enrolled in a Pennsylvania College or University. It is not a requirement to be enrolled in a Pennsylvania program to be eligible for the paid internship.
