A. PRE-ENTRY CHECKS

VEHICLE CONDITION

-BODY, TIRES, GLASS, LEAKS, DEBRIS, PETS, CHILDREN

- B. ENTRY/ADJUSTMENTS
- Key in ignition, lock doors
- 2. ADJUST SEAT/STEERING/HEADREST

2 CLICKS OF IGNITION = POWER

3. Adjust Mirrors to BSGR

C. IDENTIFY CONTROLS-/ LOCATE/CHECK

BRAKE, GAS, (CLUTCH) PEDALS

DASHBOARD /WARNING LIGHTS

HEADLIGHTS/HIGH & LOW BEAM

TURN SIGNAL & HAZARD LIGHTS (4-WAYS)

STEERING WHEEL-CRUISE CONTROL/HORN

WIPER/WASHERS

VISIBILITY/COMFORT/(HEAT A/C, REAR DEFROST, DEFOG)

GEAR SELECTOR, PARKING BRAKE *

- . STARTING
- FOOT ON BRAKE (HEEL ON FLOOR)
- HAND ON WHEEL
- CHECK GEAR/TURN KEY TO START

MOVING/STOPPING/FRONT REFERENCE/SECURE/SHUT DOWN

MOVING FORWARD-

- 1. Foot on Brake
- 2. Gear to D
- 3. Parking Brake release
- 4. Release brake pedal/Aim ahead/move forward
- 5. Control Braking/Smooth stop

ACCELERATION & BRAKING CONTROL

- 1. Foot pivots on heel to gas pedal
- 2. Accelerate smoothly upward to 20-25 mph in 5-mph increases in a straight line
- 3. Decelerate slowly downward 5mph decreases
- 4. Smooth Braking to stopping points

STEERING/TURNING/SIGNALS

9 & 3 hand position/ Hand-over/Push-Pull Techs.

All movement left or right forward, rear, sides <u>require</u> direction signals

REVERSE

BACKING STRAIGHT

- 1. Left Hand @ 12 o'clock on wheel,
- Look to rear path through rear window/check sides/
- 3. release P Brake/
- 4. move to target/smooth stop to rear ref pt./
- secure pb/ Shift to P
- Look to direction of back turn /signal/quick refer to front/ sides/back to direction

BACKING & STEERING

Driving in reverse is the same as driving forward.

- 1. Look along your path of travel.
- 2. Steer to your target.
- ⇒ Turn steering wheel left-car goes left
- ⇒ Turn wheel right, car goes right

Be aware of hazards from the sides and front

RESIDENTIAL ROUTE

Characteristics

- MINIMAL TRAFFIC
- POSTED SPEEDS— UP TO 25 MPH
- MINIMAL SIGNS AND MARKINGS
 STOP, FEW WARNING. CROSS WALKS
- INTERSECTIONS, DRIVEWAYS, ALLEY WAYS
 BLIND & OPEN
- "RESIDENTIAL" ACTIVITIES

=WALKING, JOGGING, CYCLISTS, CHILDREN, PETS

OBJECTIVES-PROCEDURE/SKILLS PRACTICE

- ENTER STREET
 - = REAR CHECK >SIGNAL >BLIND SPOT
- IDENTIFY SIGNS
- ADJUSTMENTS TO CONDITIONS
 SPEED & LANE POSITION TO AVOID CONFLICT

- ID HAZARDS-AWARENESS & AVOIDANCE
 - = SEARCH TECHNIQUES
- IDENTIFY INTERSECTION TYPES AND SIGNS

T-INTER, Y, UNCONTROLLED, 1-2-3-4-WAY STOP

- IDENTIFY STOPPING POINTS @ INTERSECTIONS
 BEFORE: CROSSWALK, STOP LINE, SIDEWALK, EDGE OF ROAD
- MIRROR USE
- COMPLETE /SMOOTH STOP, 2ND STOP AS NEEDED
- CROSSING &TURNS

RIGHT OF WAY

LEFT & RIGHT-MOVING & STATIONARY

GAP SELECTION, LANE ENTRY, STEERING TECH

2ND GLANCE, SCAN THROUGH TURN, MIRROR

- MOVING TO CURB OR SIDE OF STREET
 =SEARCH, SIGNAL, BLIND SPOT
- PARKING &SECURING

- ACCELERATOR STICK/ UNINTENDED ACCELERATION
- ABS BRAKING /EVASIVE STEERING
- COUNTERSTEER FOR REAR WHEEL TRACTION LOSS

OPEN HIGHWAY

CHARACTERISTICS

- TRAFFIC-MODERATE TO HEAVY
- SPEEDS -VARY
 30-55 MPH
- LANES-MULTIPLE

 TWO-DIRECTION /ONE DIRECTION

 PROTECTED TURNING LANES

 INTERSECTIONS & MULTIPLE LANE INT.
- SIGNS, SIGNALS, MARKINGS
 SIGNS-WARNING-EXACT, 3-5 SECONDS AWAY
 REGULATORY-SPEED, LANE USE
 GUIDE-DIRECTION, DISTANCE, ROAD I.D.
 SIGNALS-TRAFFIC LIGHTS/TURNING LANES
 MARKINGS—CENTER/PASSING/NO PASSING/COLOR
 FOG LINE-WHITE/RIGHT
- SIGHT DISTANCES/VARIABLE SEARCH AREAS
 = CURVES / HILLS
- MAY HAVE RESIDENTIAL OR EXPRESSWAY ASPECTS

- VEHICLE CONTROL /LANE POSTIONS @ HIGHER SPEEDS
 I.D. & ADJUST TO CONDITIONS & CHANGES

 SPEED –conditions, hazards, signs

 NEGOTIATING Curves & Intersections

 -CURVES-SET UP, SPEED –slow & BRAKE STRAIGHT
- ORDERLY SEARCH PATTERN/ ACT ON, NOT REACT TO.
 I.D., READ, Act on Warning signs

-INTERSECTIONS-R OF WAY, GAP, SCAN THROUGH SIDES

- REGULAR & ROUTINE MIRROR USE
 PASSING/NO PASSING ZONES
 SLOWING, OUT OF CURVES, TRAFFIC SIGNALS, STOPS
- LANE CHANGES

PROCEDURE-SEARCH, SIGNAL, BLIND SPOT, CHANGE, MIRROR
INTO TURNING LANE
MERGE

PASSING /BEING PASSED

EXPRESSWAY/INTERCHANGES

CHARACTERISTICS

- TRAFFIC-LIGHT TO HEAVY
- SPEEDS-POSTED 65-70 MPH
- LANES -MULTIPLE TRAVEL LANES

2 OR MORE, ONE DIRECTION

LIMITED ACCESS & EXIT—BY INTERCHANGES

SPECIFIC EXITS & ENTRANCES

MERGES & EXITS- FROM RIGHT AND LEFT

WEAVE LANE (SHARED EXIT /ENTRANCE)

NO INTERSECTIONS, PHYSICAL BARRIER SEPARATES LANE DIRECTION

SIGNS / SIGNALS

ENTRY METERING

GREEN GUIDE FOR EXITS / DISTANCES & LOCATION YELLOW WARNING-MERGES, CURVES, RAMP SPEEDS SPEED LIMITS LANE USE SIGNALS

ELECTRONIC MESSAGE SIGNS

COURTESY LANE CHANGES-

NECESSITY/ABILTY TO PERFORM

MERGE LANE AWARENESS – MIRRORS AS PASSING BY

- LANE CHANGES
- PASSING /BEING PASSED
- INCREASED AWARENESS AROUND CAR
- <u>USE CRUISE CONTROL</u> CORRECTLY * (WEATHER)
- MIRROR USE ROUTINE & REGULAR

MODERATE SUBURBAN/SHOPPING

CHARACTERISTICS

- MAXIMUM POSTED SPEEDS 35-45 MPH
- INCREASED NUMBER OF USERS

ACTIVITY FROM ALL DIRECTIONS

EXITING /ENTERING BUSINESS LOTS

LIMITED SPACE AND VISIBILITY

CURBS TO RIGHT

POSSIBLE LANES TO LEFT

MULTIPLE LANE AND COMPLEX INTERSECTIONS

DEDICATED DIRECTIONAL LANES

SHARED DIRECTIONAL LANES

GREATER NUMBER OF TRAFFIC CONTROLS

LANE USE, WARNING, SPEED SIGNS

VARIOUS SIGNAL LIGHTS

PROTECTED TURNS

UNPROTECTED TURNS

COMBINED

OBJECTIVES/SKILLS

SCAN THROUGH ALL TURNS

GAP SELECTION

SET-UP FOR LEFT TURNS @ INTERSECTIONS

SHARED LEFT TURN ONLY USE

RIGHT TURN ON RED

- ANTICIPATE CHANGING TRAFFIC SIGNALS
- REGULAR & ROUTINE MIRROR USE

URBAN BUSINESS DISTRICT

CHARACTERISTICS

- LARGE VOLUME OF TRAFFIC & ACTIVITY
 TIME OF DAY
 (MOTOR VEHICLES, BICYCLISTS, PEDESTRIANS
 BUSES, TAXI, DELIVERY)
- SPECIAL LANES FOR SELECTIVE USE
- PROTECTED AND UNPROTECTED TURNS
- COMPLEX INTERSECTIONS
- RESTRICTED SPACE

OBJECTIVES/ SKILLS

- MAKING LEFT AND RIGHT TURNS FROM MULTIPLE LANES ONTO MULTIPLE-LANE STREETS
- MAKING LANE CHANGES
 PROCEDURE
 BLIND SPOTS CHECKS
- INTERACT WITH OTHER USERS
- YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS
- ENTER AND EXIT ALLEYWAYS
- NEGOTIATE AN OFF-SET INTERSECTION
 PROPER POSITION FOR LEFT TURN
- SCAN THROUGH TURNS
- ENTER CORRECT LANE FROM TURN
- SELECTIVE & ROUTINE MIRROR USE
- PREDICT CHANGING TRAFFIC SIGNALS
- NAVIGATE ONE-WAY STREETS
- REGULAR & ROUTINE MIRROR USE

RURAL ENVIRONMENT (Back Roads)

CHARACTERISTICS

- POSTED SPEEDS MAY VARY UP TO 45 MPH
- MINIMAL TRAFFIC, USERS VARY
- = LOCAL, RECREATIONAL, FARMING
- LANES VARIOUS WIDTHS

USUALLY UNMARKED

= LIMITED SPACE TO RIGHT

SOLID IMPACT=TREES, POLES, ROCKS

EMBANKEMENTS=DITCHES, CULVERTS, NARROW BRIDGES

TRAFFIC SIGNS

WARNING SIGNS & SPEED LIMITS

VARIOUS MATERIALS & MAINTENANCE

DIRT, GRAVEL, PAVED, MUD

POTHOLES, CRUMBLING EDGES, DEBRIS

DRAINAGE, SNOW DRIFTS, ICE, WIND

- = LIMITED TRACTION
- SIGHTLINES (CHANGE WITH SEASON)
- CURVES /BLIND CURVES

- HILLS
 - = ALL LIMIT VISIBILTY
- WILDLIFE & FARM ANIMALS

BROAD, AGGRESSIVE SCANNING—BE AWARE OF MOVMENT

DO NOT SWERVE !!!

PERCEPTUAL OBJECTIVES/SKILLS

- READ AND ACT ON SIGNS
- IDENTIFY AND RESPOND TO LIMITED HIGHWAY CONDITIONS
- IDENTIFY LOCATIONS OF HIDDEN SIDE ROADS, LANES AND DRIVEWAYS
- RESPOND TO RIGHT WHEEL DROP-OFF ONTO SHOULDER
- IDENTIFY AREAS OF LIMITED SPACE, VISIBILITY OR TRACTION
- SAFE SPEED THROUGH CURVES (SLOWDOWN, BRAKE WHILE STRAIGHT)
- SLOW WHEN RESPONDING TO RIGHT WHEEL DROP-OFF
- DROP-OFF RECOVERY
- MIRROR USE
