**Position Title: Assistant Professor of Psychology**

The Department of Psychology and Counseling at Arkansas State University (A-State) seeks a tenure-track Assistant Professor in Psychology for the undergraduate B.S. degree in psychology and the Ed.S. degree in psychology and counseling (school psychology track). The area of scholarship/research is open.

**Responsibilities include:** The successful candidate will contribute to the undergraduate psychology program and the Ed.S. school psychology program. Teaching duties will include undergraduate courses in educational psychology and introduction to psychology and possible graduate courses in school psychology and involvement with this graduate track pending qualifications. Teaching load for this position is typically four courses each semester.

Other duties will include student advisement and mentoring, maintaining an active research program, and service to the programs, department, college, and university. Summer teaching may be available.

**Qualifications include:** A Ph.D. in school or educational psychology from an accredited university and program. ABD will be considered; however, the degree must be awarded at the time the position starts.

**Required Documentation:** Applicants must complete the online application. In addition, the following materials should also be submitted: (1) a cover letter, (2) curriculum vita, (3) a statement of teaching philosophy, (4) a statement of research interests and agenda, (5) three letters of recommendation, and (6) unofficial transcripts from all colleges/universities attended.
