

UNIVERSITY SENATE

The first meeting of the University Senate of Indiana University of Pennsylvania was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 11, 1966, in the Demonstration Room of Keith School by Dr. Willis E. Pratt, University President. John A. Polesky was appointed temporary secretary. Dr. Pratt announced that the purpose of the meeting was to elect a Vice Chairman and a seven-member nominating committee.

Lorrie J. Bright said that many members of the Senate felt that the election of a Vice Chairman should be postponed until the next meeting in order to give more time to consider nominees for that position. Mr. Bright then moved that the election of Vice Chairman be postponed until the nominating committee had a chance to think about candidates and that the election be held at the next meeting. Charles E. Weber seconded the motion. A count was made of the persons present and the 128 present constituted a quorum. The motion was carried.

Dr. Pratt appointed the following as tellers for the voting based on having the longest service to the University: Dwight E. Sollberger, Florence Wallace, Edward W. Bieghler, Ralph W. Reynolds, and Leola T. Norberg. Nominations were then opened for candidates for the nominating committee. A separate vote was to be made for candidates from each of the seven groups comprising the Senate. The persons receiving the highest and second highest number of votes in each group were to be voted on a second time to determine the one person from each group to be on the nominating committee.

Nominations were opened for Group 1—Education, and Ralph M. Glott, James C. Wilson, Stanley W. Lore, and Lois C. Blair were nominated. Maurice L. Rider moved and Werner J. Fries seconded that nominations be closed. The motion carried.

Nominations were opened for Group 2—Natural Sciences and Mathematics. Martin L. Stapleton, James E. McKinley, Daniel G. Reiber, Walter W. Gallati, and William R. Smith were nominated. Stanley W. Lore moved and Clyde C. Gelbach seconded
