I. Call to Order

II. On a Baumler/Greenawalt motion the minutes from the September 20, 2011 Curriculum Committee Meeting were approved.

III. Co-Chairs Report:

An update on Assessment for Liberal Studies was given by Dave Pistole. Suggested revisions included:

- Remove the last sentence.
- Change the wording of the second sentence to “As such, this process focuses on the faculty member’s active engagement with the use of an assessment of their own design.”
- For the revision to the UWUCC Handbook, it was suggested that “response to questions” be referenced as only referring to LS courses.
- The Committee approved the assessment piece.

V. Items for Review/Possible Action:

- a. 11-31 BIOL 118 The History of Pain, Distance Education
 - Change the online objectives back to what is in the syllabus of record.
 - Change evaluations to have a sum of 100%.
 - Move the cover page to page 1.
 - On a Lewis/Boser motion the course was approved.
- b. 11-35 CRIM 394 Crime and Delinquency Prevention, Distance Education
 - Clarify language between ‘discussion’ and ‘assignment.’
 - Fix typos:
 - Under “Pace of Course,” change the wording of “course will progress fast.”
 - Under “Discussion Questions,” 2nd paragraph, change ‘evaluate’ to ‘evaluated.’
 - On a Boser/Deckert motion the course was provisionally approved. Lewis abstained
- c. 11-15 Athletic Training, program revision
 - Received a letter of support from the Military Science Department since 4-26-11
 - The Liberal Studies Committee has since 4-26-11 now approved this change.
 - On a Migyanka/Knight motion the program revision was approved.
- d. 11-23a Asian Studies Major, program revision
 - On a Lewis/Fair motion the program revision was approved.
- e. 11-23b CHIN 201 Intermediate Chinese, course revision, catalog description change

- There is also a name change – from Intermediate Chinese III to Intermediate Chinese.
 - Suggestion: Delete Intermediate Chinese IV
 - On a Fair/Baumler motion the course revision was approved. There were 2 abstentions.
- f. 11-23c CHIN 102 Elementary Chinese II, course revision, catalog description change
- There is also a name change - from Chinese II to Elementary Chinese II
 - On a Baumler/Fair motion the revision was approved. There were 2 abstentions.
- g. 11-23d CHIN 101 Elementary Chinese I, course revision, catalog description change
- On a Migyanka/Fair motion the course revision was approved.
- h. 11-13 B.S. in Education-Early Childhood Education/Special Education Urban Track, new track
- Footnote by History should be by Natural Science on the page with the new program.
 - On a Boser/Lewis motion the new track was approved. Migyanka abstained.
