III. Co-Chairs Report:

Inactive Classes Policy

- An email from Marcy Rearick was reviewed concerning inactive courses—we have been asked along with the graduate committee to develop a policy.
- CHEM 342 - CNSM College Curriculum Committee discussed the prerequisite issue with the course and in the end supports the course revision as it was approved by UWUCC. It will be taken to Senate since UWUCC already passed the course.
- Biology Dept. changes to several BIOL courses have affected other departments. Changes to programs resulting from this will be fast tracked. The Liberal Studies Office will identify the affected programs and provide a template for the corrections.

 - Remove “ENGL 121 and” from the Humanities line, remove MATH 152 (Liberal Studies MATH elective)” from the Mathematics line
 - Remove “as mentioned above –” from the LS Elective line
 - EDUC 499 is too small
 - MATH 413 needs to be added under Required Middle Level Courses
 - Move MIDL 310 to make it numerical.
 - A number of the course titles in the Middle Level section are incomplete
 - Remove \$ after EDEX 301 in matrix
 - Add the standard *Footnote that is in all education degrees “*See requirements leading to teacher certification . . .”
 - Put in the revised catalog description paragraph(s) for the 4 specialization
 - On a VanDyke/Lewis motion the track was provisionally approved. One abstention.
- b. 12-14c BSED Middle Level Education 4-8/Social Studies Specialization, new track
 - Change "It is expected..." to "It is required."
 - Remove \$ after MIDL 315 in matrix
 - EDUC 499 is too small
 - A number of the course titles in the Middle Level section are incomplete
 - Add the standard *Footnote that is in all education degrees “*See requirements leading to teacher certification . . .”

 - Under Rationale, somewhat is misspelled

 - On a Greenawalt/Deckert motion the change was approved
- l. 12-51a BA History, program revision
 - Minor in history listed as 15 cr. should be 18 cr.
 - Should transfer credits be 6 or 9 now that minor credits are increasing?
 - HIST 295 and 395 have not been approved they were returned in January
 - Change the last paragraph under Part II to "Every student should consider" and remove "should be investigated."
 - Proposal postponed
- m. 12-51b BA History/Pre-Law Track, program revision
 - Need to add ENGL 265
 - Same comments as above proposal
 - Proposal postponed
- n. 12-49 ECON 143 Financial Wellness, new course
 - On a Lewis/Fair motion the course was approved.
- o. 12-21 FCSE 143 Financial Wellness, new course
 - On a Lewis/Fair motion the course was approved.
