



- g. 16-80 THTR 347 Playwriting, course revision, catalog description change

  - Explain certification status.

- i. 16-83 MUSC 420/520 Professional Practices, course revision, catalog description change, course title change, add dual level
- Credits: 2-0l-2cr (1 not number 1).
  - Catalog description 1<sup>st</sup> sentence: Applies or Explores skills ...
  - Remove the last line of catalog description that starts “Dual-level . . .”
  - On a Deckert/Miller motion, the proposal was provisionally approved. Clewell Abstained.
- j. [16-90 ARED 317 Art in K-6 Programs, distance education
- The proposer requested that the committee review the proposal before the end of the fall semester because the department needed to accommodate several students who just completed Step 1. An email vote for approval was conducted on 12-7 thru 12-8.
  - The only issues raised dealt with procedures not with the course itself.
  - On a Killam/Greenawalt motion, the proposal was approved.]
