 - Course outline is listing lectures and does not include course content in outline.

- l. 16-38c INDS 313 Building Systems I: Materials and Finishes, catalog description change, course title change (was Materials and Finishes), modified prerequisite, course revision
 - No rationale for why prerequisites are being removed
 - Catalog description: Introduces basic methods of ... Focuses on.... Examines... Considers relevant codes.. Do you really need the last sentence?
 - Course outline is listing lectures and does not include course content in outline.
 - On a Kleinman/Fair motion, the proposal was provisionally approved.
