I. Call to Order

II. On a Greenawalt/Killam motion, the minutes from August 30th 2016 were approved as presented.

III. Co-Chairs Report

16-34h BS Public Health, new program—the State System office said that the required minor or certificate should be changed to recommended so a footnote 3 was added to recommend a minor or certificate. One of the tracks was missing in the footnote reference about math. The Natural Science College curriculum committee had suggested that MATH 216 or 217 should be in Liberal Studies and the MATH 121 requirement should be in the track. The Liberal Studies committee, however, discussed this and felt that the Math requirement should remain the way it is since MATH 121 is a preq for MATH 216. The History Department was upset with the title Introduction to History of Public Health for PUBH 122. The entire proposal was reviewed to make sure that it was consistent with all of the changes.
