VI. 21-64 ENGL 103 Composition I Accelerated, new course, distance education

- Bryna described how students are placed into ENGL composition courses. ENGL department has determined that a new placement course is needed to serve students.
- The new course is designed to provide students with an accelerated version of composition.
- Courses designated as ENGL-103 would count for ENGL-101.
- The course is planned to be offered as face-to-face and online.
- Based on placement testing a student would be designated to take ENGL-101 or 103.
- There was a substantial discussion on the enrollment issues and seat availability in ENGL-100, 101, and 202 sections. There were concerns raised by UWUCC members about adding an additional level of complexity to ENGL placement.
