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| Rationale for Proposed Changes | |
| (A) Why is the program being revised?* | <p>Two changes to the track in Instructional Design and Technology in the MA in Adult and Community Education are being proposed:</p> <p>1) It is proposed that prospective students be required to submit a resume as a document for admissions to the program. A resume has always been required, but we were informed by Admissions that this practice needs to be formalized. This proposal is intended to formalize the resume requirement for admissions.</p> <p>2) It is proposed that the thesis requirement be increased from three to six credits for students electing the thesis option. The rationale for this change is to recognize the amount of work required for a thesis and to encourage students to take the thesis option. This change will result in thesis option students taking six credit hours of ACE 795 (Thesis) in lieu of an elective and ACE 744, Program and Project Evaluation. ACE 744 is a research based course in which students complete a program evaluation research project. Since the thesis is an intensive research experience, the thesis is a good substitute for ACE 744. The total number of credit hours (36) required for graduation will not change.</p> |

The outcomes are listed below.</p> <p>The purpose of the program is to help students acquire knowledge and skills in theory and research in instructional design, training, adult education, and in the applications of current and emerging instructional technologies in education and training. Upon completion of the program, students will be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Design education and training programs for a variety of settings and learners, including developing goals and objectives, developing learning activities, and conducting learner assessment. 2. Apply adult development and learning theory to the design and implementation of training and educational programs. 3. Plan educational and training programs which incorporate the use of educational technology, needs assessment, and program evaluation. 4. Analyze the importance of leadership and management skills in the planning, conducting, and evaluation of instructional design and education and training programs. 5. Create effective learning events employing distance education pedagogy. 6. Critically analyze the literature in instructional design and technology using knowledge of research methods. 7. Apply instructional technology to develop effective learning modules. 8. Select, design, produce, and evaluate instructional technology for education and training programs. 9. Apply principles of ethics as they relate to the use of media and technology instructional design and education and training programs. 10. Integrate technology with the teaching and training of learners. 11. Obtain practical experience in the design, development, implementation, and evaluation of technology and adult learning. |
| <p>(C) Implications of the change on the program, other programs and the Students:*</p> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) There are no implications of these proposed changes for other programs. 2) There are no implications for current students. It is proposed that the changes take effect Fall 2017 semester. There are no students currently enrolled in thesis, so no current students are affected. Students have been required to submit a resume for admissions in the past so this requirement does not change. 3) There are no implications for the program. The resume requirement remains the same and the total number of credits required for graduation do not change as a result of this proposal. |
