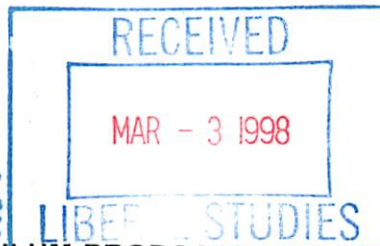

Attached is a proposal for revising the Bachelor of Science in Art Education degree for consideration by the University Wide Undergraduate Curriculum Committee. All steps of the curriculum process have been taken, and all necessary signatures are on the cover page.

Essentially, the degree program is simply changing the requirement for special education from EX 300 The Exceptional Child in Regular Classroom to EX 301 Education of Students with Disabilities in Inclusive Secondary Programs. This change is consistent with the same change being made in other secondary education programs.
