

Part II. Description of the Curriculum Change

1. An exact statement of what is to be deleted.

The course listing BIOL 321 Environmental Protection I is to be deleted.

2. Justification/Rationale

BIOL 321 Environmental Protection I is being revised and its revision includes a course prefix, number, and name change to ENVH 221 Environmental Health and Protection I. Therefore, BIOL 321 Environmental Protection I should be deleted to make this prefix and number available for a future new biology course.

3. Revision of BIOL 321 Environmental Protection I to ENVH 221 Environmental Health and Protection I is part of an Environmental Health Program Curriculum Revision Proposal; designed to update the Program and to make it suitable for accreditation by the National Environmental Health Science and Protection Accreditation Council. BIOL 321 is a currently a required course for Environmental Health majors, and a controlled elective for Environmental Geoscience majors. They will be able to take ENVH 221 in lieu of BIOL 321.
