Part II. Description of the Curriculum Change

1. An exact statement of what is to be deleted.

The minor in Environmental Health is to be deleted.

2. Justification/Rationale

The B.S. in Environmental Health Science is being revised to a B.S. in Biology / Environmental Health Track. Therefore, students will minor in Biology rather than in Environmental Health.

3. Students currently enrolled in the Environmental Health minor are required to take ENVH 221 Environmental Health and Protection I, ENVH 222 Environmental Health and Protection II, ENVH 323 Introduction to Toxicology and Risk Assessment, and ENVH 460 Fundamentals of Environmental Epidemiology. As part of the Environmental Health Science program revision, ENVH 221 and ENVH 222 are being merged into BIOL 221, and all ENVH courses are being deleted while retaining their BIOL cross-listed counterparts. Environmental Health minors can take BIOL 221 and a controlled biology environmental health track elective in lieu of ENVH 221 and ENVH 222, and they can take BIOL 323 and BIOL 460 in lieu of ENVH 323 and ENVH 460.
