Part II. Description of the Curriculum Change

1. An exact statement of what is to be deleted.

The course listing for ENVH 222 Environmental Health and Protection II is to be deleted.

2. Justification/Rationale

The B.S. in Environmental Health Science is being revised to a B.S. in Biology / Environmental Health Track. Combining ENVH 221 Environmental Health and Protection I and ENVH 222 Environmental Health and Protection II into BIOL 221 Environmental Health and Protection is part of this program revision. In addition, all ENVH course listings are being deleted. Therefore, ENVH 222 is no longer needed.

3. ENVH 222 is currently required for a B.S. in Environmental Health Science and a minor in Environmental Health. Students currently enrolled in these programs can take a controlled biology environmental health track elective in lieu of ENVH 222.
