The course listing for ENVH 270 Food Safety and Protection is to be deleted.

2. Justification/Rationale

The B.S. in Environmental Health Science is being revised to a B.S. in Biology / Environmental Health Track. All ENVH course listings are no longer needed and will be deleted as part of this program revision. ENVH 270 Food Safety and Protection is cross-listed as BIOL 270 Food Safety and Protection which will be retained.

3. ENVH 270 is currently a controlled elective for a B.S. in Environmental Health Science. Students currently enrolled in this program can take BIOL 270 in lieu of ENVH 270.
