1. Catalog Description:

BIOL 352 Comparative Animal Physiology 2c-3l-3cr

Prerequisites: BIOL 220, CHEM 231

A comparative study of homeostatic mechanisms and systems in animals and their relation to fundamental chemical and physical events in cells.

3. Justification/rationale for the changes:

The Biology Department adopted a new curriculum in Fall 2014. BIOL 201 replaces BIOL 112. Students in the BIOL majors will typically sequentially complete BIOL 201, BIOL 202 and BIOL 203. However, students who completed BIOL 202 are not able to enroll in BIOL 352 because of the current prerequisites.
