The matter of the prefix for the 382 course has become more complicated. When I talked to the departmental secretary about why the course was being scheduled as BL 382 instead of FI 382, she indicated that the prefix was originally changed from AD 382 to FI 382 in December of 1990 as a part of the reorganization. Apparently, the faculty did not like the FI prefix and submitted a change from FI 382 to BL 382 in September 1991. She reminded me that the argument at the time pertaining to the prefix focused on the proposition that the course dealt largely with real estate contracts. Even though the course is usually in the finance area at other schools, I apparently accepted the rationale and signed off on the course number change. I have copied those change forms for your review. According to Gary Buterbaugh, the change form never was entered in the docket for the University Wide Curriculum Committee.

To rectify the foregoing problem, we should allow BL 383 to stand as approved recently by the Senate and then act ex post facto on the request for FI 382 to be changed to BL 382. Once the curriculum committee has acted on this request, Diane Duntley can change the catalog to be consistent with our recent practice. Your cooperation in having the committee act on this matter will be appreciated.
