Part II: Description of Curriculum Change

- 1. CHEM 410 (0c-3*l*-1cr), Advanced Inorganic Chemistry Laboratory, is being deleted.
- 2. Rationale: Advanced Inorganic Chemistry has traditionally been taught in our department as a three credit lecture (CHEM 411) plus the one credit, three hour laboratory (CHEM 410). Both required courses tend to be taken in the fall semester of a Chemistry major's senior year. In response to changes from our accrediting agency, the American Chemical Society (ACS), the CHEM 411 has been and streamlined into a combined three credit lecture and lab. The course revision for CHEM 411 is in this package.
- 3. **Effect on students/courses:** This course is taken only by Chemistry majors. Its deletion will have no impact on students, but will reduce the prep counts associated with the delivery of Advanced Inorganic Chemistry. The one credit will be transferred to the Intermediate Inorganic Chemistry course (CHEM 214, proposal also in package), in keeping with current ACS requirements.
