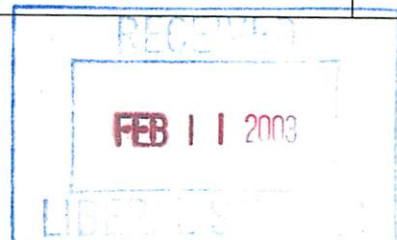

Category 1—Liberal Studies requirements for math and liberal studies free electives changed; also reducing the Professional Education Sequence as allowed by the December 3, 2002 action of the IUP Senate to eliminate FDED102 as a core requirement. In summary, the proposed catalog language reflects these three changes, allowing the Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology program to reduce to a total of 120 credits:

- *Increasing the liberal studies math requirement from 3 to 6 credits*
- *Decreasing the liberal studies elective requirement from 9 to 6 credits, with one course continuing to be directed in this category to allow our students to meet professional credentialing needs*
- *Eliminating FDED102 from the Professional Education Sequence*

SPLP420 is listed as an optional major course in the current program. For the sake of clarity, it is listed as a recommended free elective in the proposed program. The functional status of this course in the curriculum is unchanged.
