A study of database concepts. A detailed study of information concepts and the realization of those concepts using the relational data model. Practical experience gained designing and constructing data models and using SQL to interface to both multi-user DBMS packages and to desktop DBMS packages.

COSC 341 Introduction to Database Management Systems

3c-01-3cr

Prerequisites: COSC 220 (or equivalent) and 310 or instructor permission

A study of database concepts. A detailed study of information concepts and the realization of those concepts using the relational data model. Practical experience gained designing and constructing data models and using SQL to interface to both multi-user DBMS packages and to desktop DBMS packages.

3. Justification/rationale for the change.

Database Management Systems have evolved to the point that storage structures (external data structures) are well hidden. Algorithms no longer need to navigate data structures thus the removal of COSC 310. COSC 310 has been replaced by COSC 110 in which students learn enough programming skills.

The database technology has matured to a point where the knowledge of the topics covered in COSC 220 (Cobol) is no longer required in order to study database systems. The database language SQL is used in COSC 341 rather than Cobol. As such, the prerequisite of COSC 220 has been removed.
