The Computer Science Department would like to request approval for the following change to our degree requirements. This change has been approved by the Computer Science Department Curriculum Committee and the Computer Science Department Faculty:

Credit for CO 320, Software Engineering Practicum, and CO 493, Internship in Computer Science, may not both be counted toward the Computer Science Major.

Rationale:

CO 320, Software Engineering Practicum, is designed to provide an experience in software development (this includes interacting with the user to develop specifications, designing the solution, implementing the solution, testing the solution, developing user documentation, etc.) for the student who does not have an intern experience. The student taking CO 493 will be exposed to these same development steps through his internship experience.
