IV. DESCRIPTION OF CURRICULUM CHANGE

Change the requirements for the Computer Science major, pp. 89-90 in the 1989-90 catalog, as follows:

OLD CATALOG DESCRIPTION

CO 105 Fundamentals of Computer Science	3 sh
CO 110 Problem Solving and Structured Programming	3 sh
Free Electives:	0 - 21
Total Degree Requirements	124

RATIONALE FOR CHANGE

This change is required to implement the proposed CO 105 course. Note that our majors still have 0-21 credits of free electives. The variation in the number of free electives is based on which Math sequences they elect, whether they have to take the first two semesters of a foreign language to satisfy the foreign language requirement, and their choices relative to a Minor or Concentration in Business.
