## **Part II. Description of Curriculum Change**

### **1. New course description**

**CO 362 Unix and C**

**3c-01-3sh**

**Prerequisites: CO 310 or permission of instructor**

An introduction to the history, features, syntax, and applications of Unix and C. Lectures, reading, and hands-on projects. Coverage includes two or more command interfaces, variations in C, and portability issues.

### **2. Old course description**

**CO 362 Unix and C**

**3c-01-3sh**

**Prerequisites: CO 310 or permission of instructor**

Provides a general introduction to UNIX and C including historical roots, current practice, prospects for the future, and hands-on skills. Students will develop understanding of the features, syntax, and "culture" of UNIX and C through lectures, reading, and projects. UNIX and C will be studied both separately and in synergistic combination. Upon completion of the course, students will have immediately practical awareness and some skills and will be provided with a foundation for further coursework in operating systems, compiler construction, and/or graduate study. UNIX is a trademark of Bell Laboratories.

### **3. Rationale for the change**

The new catalog description is simply a better wording. There is no substantive change.
