Part II: Description of Curriculum Change

1. Catalog Description

CRIM 450 Women and Crime

3 class hours

0 lab hours

Prerequisites: CRIM 101 and CRIM 102

3 semester hours

(3c-0l-3sh)

A study of the nature and extent of women's crime, theories of female criminality, processing of women offenders through the criminal justice system, the response of police and court officials to women as victims of crime, and opportunities for women as employees in criminal justice agencies.

3. Justification for number change

This course is being proposed as one of 3 controlled electives in Group C (see new curriculum on pp 3-4). We are re-numbering this course to match the numbers of the other courses in Group C, to permit easy identification for students.

The prerequisite requirement is added to insure that all students enrolled in this course have completed a course on criminological theory and a course on the criminal justice system prior to beginning this class.
