<b>(A) Why is the program being revised?*</b>	EDSP 468 is a course that can be substituted in the Educational Psychology Minor when a student is having trouble completing the required 18 credits. The courses are not offered each semester. EDSP 468 will be offered each year during the winter break helping students to fulfill the 18 credits requirement. EDSP 376 was recently changed to EDSP 476/576. The course can be taken the approval of the Educational Psychology Minor advisor. This option will allow more flexibility in completing the Minor before seniors graduate.
