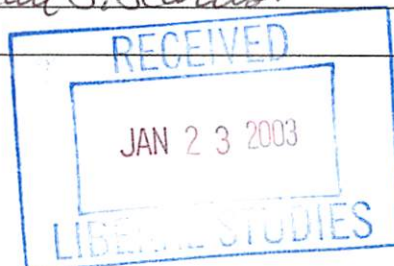

## **Part II: Description of Curriculum Change**

### **Catalog description of newly numbered course:**

#### **ENGL 426 ESL Methods and Materials**

3c-01-3sh

**Prerequisite:** Senior standing or permission of the instructor.

An introduction to English as a Second Language theory and practice. Aims: (1) general understanding of current theory and methods of teaching ESL; (2) ability to select appropriate, and adapt existing, materials for elementary and high school ESL students.

### **Previous course name and number:**

ENGL 334 ESL Methods and Materials

### **Proposed change:**

ENGL 426 ESL Methods and Materials

### **Rationale for change:**

As more non-native speakers of English enroll in American public secondary schools, it is increasingly important that IUP English Education graduates prepare specifically for working with generation one, generation one and a half, and generation two English language learners. This course has existed on the books, but has not been taught regularly. In response to changing demographics, we encourage our English Education undergraduates to take this course, and it fits best into their program of study at the senior level. The M.A. in Teaching English program revision that is forthcoming includes the graduate counterpart of this course as a program requirement. Thus, this number change anticipates the request for dual level approval of this course so that we can meet enrollment levels necessary to offer the course regularly.
