1. **ENGL 222** **Technical Writing** **3c-01-3cr**
Prerequisites: ENGL 101

Focuses on helping the student to acquire and to apply communication skills essential to the technical and professional writer.

ENGL 322 Technical Writing I 3c-01-3cr
Prerequisite: ENGL 202

Focuses on helping the student to acquire and to apply communication skills essential to the technical and professional writer.

3. The title change reflects the fact that there is no longer a “Technical Writing II” course.
