#### 3. Rationale

**Prerequisite change** from ENGL 202, 210, 211, 212, 213 to ENGL 122, 202, and one of 210-213 or 226

This is a change in pre-requisites only. Originally our curriculum was designed to force students to take all of our survey courses, in order, before moving on to upper-division courses. The realities of registration make this very difficult for students to do and still graduate in a timely manner. In addition, our program revision requires only two of the current survey courses. Limiting the prerequisites for this course to our introductory majors' course (122), Research Writing (ENGL 202), and to one of our survey courses will also allow our majors more flexibility.
