- Delete QB 215 Business Statistics as a prerequisite for FI 310 Finance I. Prerequisite should read: "AG 202 and MA 214 for business majors; AG 202 and MA 214 or MA 217 for non-business majors (MA 214 recommended)."
- 2. The course content of MA 214 or MA 217 adequately reflects the necessary preparation for the FI 310 Finance I course. The revision was necessary in view of the needs of the proposed minor in Business Administration.
- 3. This change will not affect students currently enrolled in the program. The new prerequisite MA 214 or MA 217 associates more closely with the proposed minor in Business Administration.
