The program will now be in compliance with PASSHE limitations on liberal studies credit hours. Liberal Studies electives will be reduced from 9 credit hours to 6 credit hours by eliminating COSC/IFMG 101 or IFMG 110. Business majors will now be required to take COSC/IFMG 101 or IFMG 110 as part of the Business Administration Core, increasing the required hours from 33 credit hours to 36 credit hours. In order to maintain total major requirements at 60 hours, Major Controlled Electives will be reduced from 6 credit hours to 3 credit hours. The list of major controlled electives to choose from will not change.
