LIBERAL STUDIES

I. CATALOG DESCRIPTION

SPAN 201: Intermediate Spanish 4c-01-4cr

Prerequisite: SPAN 102 or equivalent

A continuation of previous work on listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. Students learn to function in everyday situations, expressing opinions and doubts, and narrating and describing in present, past, and future time. Exposure to cultural concepts through literary readings. Liberal Studies credit is given. Attendance is required. No student will be allowed to register for or take a D/F repeat in SPAN 201 when credit has already been received for a higher numbered course.

II. SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGE

The only change is the addition of the statement about D/F repeats.

III. JUSTIFICATION FOR THE CHANGE

This restriction would prevent students from repeating this intermediate course (SPAN 201) after having successfully earned credits in a course of more advanced level.
