



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RATIONALE FOR REVISION

Undergraduate Catalog - Requirements for Bachelor of Arts-Spanish

Under the current program students have opted not to take more than one 400 level literature course. The Bachelor of Arts degree in Spanish is a Liberal Arts degree. Literature courses are at the very heart of this program. This proposed change will give greater credibility to the Bachelor of Arts degree by requiring that students take at least two senior level Hispanic requiring that students take at least two senior level Hispanic literature courses. The Spanish for International Trade and the Spanish for Secondary Education programs will not be affected by this change.
