II. Part II Description of Curriculum Change

- 1. GEOG 371 Aerospace Workshop is to be deleted from the master course list.
- 2. Rationale: This course has not been taught since Spring of 1996. The last three times that it was offered (Spring 1995, Summer 1995, and Spring 1996) it was taught by a faculty member in another department. None of the current department faculty members are qualified to teach the course because it requires a pilot's license to teach the flight instruction portion of the course. There is no anticipated need for this course in the future for department programs.
