1) New Catalog Descriptions.

GE 352 Planning Methods

Research, analytical design, and plan-making techniques in urban and regional planning. Examines basic items necessary to prepare urban and regional comprehensive plans. (Also offered as GE 352; may not be taken for duplicate credit.)

2) Summary of proposed changes.

- a) This course is to be cross listed in both Geography and Regional Planning.
- b) The course number and title is being changed from
GE 361 Planning: Basic Studies and Analysis to **GE/RP 352 Planning Methods**.

Note: The prerequisite is the same as before (Introduction to Planning), but the prefix and number of Introduction to Planning is being changed from GE 360 to RP 350 in a parallel proposal.

3) Justification for the changes.

The cross listing will support curricular flexibility by clearly identifying Regional Planning as a separate major. This change will improve graduation check out and move us toward our goal of accreditation. The course title is being changed to better describe course content; Basic Studies and Analysis did not indicate to students that this was a course dealing with planning methods and techniques. The number is being changed to accommodate curriculum changes, clarify course sequence, and insure consistency in format.
