1. Description of Course to be Deleted GEOS 132 Historical Geology Laboratory

0c-31-1cr

Corequisite: GEOS 131

Selected problems in stratigraphic analysis, paleontology, and structural geology; designed to prepare students for upper-level geology classes. Includes field trips.

2. Justification/Rationale

The majority of the material covered in this course is being incorporated into the revised GEOS 351 Historical Geology. Essential foundational components of this lab will be incorporated into new courses, specifically GEOS 201 Foundations of Geology and GEOS 203 Surficial Processes, which are being created as part of a department-wide curriculum restructuring.
