MATH 121 and PHYS 111 are currently listed as prerequisites for this class. We want to list MATH 121 and PHYS 111 as co-requisites instead of prerequisites.

#### 3. Justification/rationale for the revision

Experience has shown that students co-enrolled in calculus and physics have the required background knowledge to succeed in this class. The companion astronomy class in the curriculum, GEOS 341 Planetary Geology, has MATH 121 and PHYS 111 listed as co-requisites, and our students have had not experienced any problems as a result. Listing these classes as co-requisites rather than pre-requisites will also make it easier for our students to schedule their classes and reduce their time-to-degree.
