All of the History department's current 300-level courses have the prerequisite "Sophomore standing; HIST 195 (nonmajors)"
We would like to change this to

"Sophomore standing; 3cr of college history"

This change will include HIST 321 Modern Britain, which is still a course but is not in the current catalog as it has not been taught in a number of years. It will also include HIST 481 Special Studies in History, which is effectively a 300-level elective and therefore should have the same prerequisite.

Rationale for Change

As HIST 195 no longer exists we would like to change that part of the prerequisite to 3cr of college history. This way both students with credit in HIST 195 and students with credit in HIST 196/7/8 will be able to enroll without having to get an override. Transfer students will also be able to enroll without an override. It has been the department's practice to give an override to transfer students with history credit for some time.

This change should have no effect on enrollment, staffing or any courses in other departments
