1. Catalog Description

HRIM 413 Advanced Restaurant Operations (1c-6l-4sh)

Prerequisites: HRIM 313 and permission

A food and beverage systems course with emphasis on restaurant frontand back-of-house operations management. Students research, plan, prepare, and present theme-oriented dinners showcasing selected domestic and international cuisine. Students function as both operations employees and managers within the department's food and beverage operation.

Prefix change corresponds to the proposed departmental name change from Hotel, Restaurant, and Institutional Management (HRIM) to Hospitality Management (HMGT). The course HMGT 413 is the third in a series of three food production and service courses within the department.
