While reviewing the narrative, we "discovered" the following hospitality management courses were not included in the catalog description:

HRIM 313 Food Production and Service
HRIM 330 Applications of Food Production and Service

Following our faculty meeting on Monday, I called Kris to inquire why those courses were left-off the list. She asked that I return the catalog information and she would back-track for us why those courses were not included. I followed-up with her by sending the email on Tuesday, June 16 that I am forwarding to you.

It appears Jeff Miller, as the chairperson, who had coordinated the new curriculum revision process, originally did not include these courses in the revision. No one is sure why he had not include them? We never agreed, as a faculty, to omit these courses from the revised curriculum.

When we "discovered" these courses "missing" on Monday, the faculty all agreed we need to "recover" them.
