1. An exact statement of what is to be deleted.

CNSV 281 Special Topics

var-1-3cr

Prerequisite: As appropriate to course content

Offered on an experimental or temporary basis to explore topics not included in the established curriculum. A given topic may be offered under any special topic identity no more than three times. Special topics numbered 281 are offered primarily for lower-level undergraduate students.

2. Justification/Rationale

The Consumer Services (CNSV) program/degree has been eliminated, and courses with the CNSV prefix are being submitted for a prefix change to FCSE. FCSE 281 Special Topics already exists. There are no students in the CNSV program who would be affected by the deletion of this course.
