Part II. Description of the Curriculum Change

The FSMR 350 and 360 classes should be deleted from the Fashion Merchandising Curriculum.

FSMR 350 was replaced by FSMR 280 Introduction to Apparel Buying. This course was approved at the October 2011 Senate Meeting.

FSMR 360 was replaced by FSMR 380 Applications in Apparel Buying, also approved at the October 2011 Senate Meeting.

Deletion of FSMR 350 and 360 will not affect existing Fashion Merchandising courses or Fashion Merchandising program as these courses have been replaced and are no longer offered.
